This organization provides both the Police Department and the community with additional resources and is comprised of a carefully selected group of community service oriented citizens who are departmentally trained to legally and competently perform the police functions on an as-needed basis. Reserves may be used to assist with Investigations and Records Management within the Police Department and/or any other assignment as directed by the Chief of Police or designee.

RECRUITING REQUIRMENTS:

- High School Diploma or GED;
- At least (21)years of age;
- Possess or able to obtain a valid State of Oregon Drivers License;
- Have safe driving record;
- Must have previously passed a Reserve Police Officer Academy.
- Be in good physical and mental health as determined by medical and psychological examination;
- Must pass extensive background investigation and be free of felony convictions.
